

His book is full of a detailed world any of would love to visit but to see it described through a child's eyes

makes it better. I always find it interesting how he describes the scenery a second time through the eyes of those who don't know they're surrounded by magic because it adds this whole other layer to the setting. I felt like I was actually walking around the Dragon Sanctuary. I wish there had been a little more about the Fairy Kingdom when Kendra went in but I cut Mull slack because he did describe it as a world undergoing repair.

His dialogue was perfect. I could feel Kendra's, and everyone else's, exasperation with Seth. Newel and Doran always make me laugh so bringing them back was a treat. I like how he really captures so many different types of character personalities to the point you feel like these are all real whether you're talking about a human or magical being.
